

Grace Church Greenwich Autumn 2022 Weekend Away  
14<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> October

**Timings:**

- You can arrive anytime between 4:30pm and 9:30pm on the Friday evening
- Dinner will be served at 6:30pm and will be available until 8:30pm
- However, if you are only staying for one night, the first session will begin at 9:30am on Saturday, so do please arrive in time for that
- For those only coming for the Saturday, please arrive by the start of the first session at 9:30am, and you are welcome to stay for dinner if you so wish, or leave after the last session in the evening
- On Sunday, most people will leave the venue gradually after lunch

**Teaching:**

- The teaching will be over 4 sessions from the book of 1 John
- There are no sessions on Friday, 3 sessions on Saturday, and 1 main session on Sunday

**Food:**

- Ashburnham will serve us dinner on Friday; breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday; and breakfast and lunch on Sunday
- They also provide morning and afternoon snacks, as well as tea, coffee and fruit
